When scholarships become available the information will be posted on the Counseling Office Google Classroom and on the A.M. and P.M. announcements. All other scholarship information may be found by searching the internet. The list of scholarships in this packet is to simply give the students an idea of how many opportunities there are for them and to encourage them to apply for as many scholarships as possible. The opportunities are endless. All deadlines are approximate and are subject to change.

Abbott & Fenner is committed to continuing their efforts at helping those who have the desire and ambition to succeed. The winner(s) of this annual scholarship will receive their award within 2 weeks of the deadline. All applicants should include their full name and mailing address with their submissions as well as the school they are currently attending. AFSCME (American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees) Family Scholarship – Approximately ten (10) \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded to children of AFSCME family members. You must fill out the application and write an essay. Visit online at www.afscme.org for more information. The deadline is December 31, 2020.

Burger King Scholarship To be eligible a student must have a cumulative GPA between 2.5 and 3.5, be an employee, child or spouse of one, be active in community service and /or co-curricular activities, and demonstrate financial need. Carey Gabay Scholarship Program provides financial assistance to five incoming SUNY State-operated campus students who exemplify Carey's commitment to social justice, leadership, and mentoring, as well as his personal story of succeeding academically despite an economically disadvantaged background. Carey grew up living in public housing and attending public school in the Bronx, New York. After a successful high school career, he went on to graduate from Harvard University and Harvard Law School. He has long been committed to public service and giving back. While at Harvard University, he ran to become the president of his undergraduate student body. In recent years, he worked tirelessly in public service, first as an Assistant Counsel to New York Governor Andrew Cuomo and more recently as First Deputy Counsel for the Empire State Development Corporation. The Carey Gabay Scholarship Program will annually

award full cost-of-attendance scholarships to five students to attend a State University of New York State-operated campus. These scholarships will cover all costs of attendance, including tuition, room and board, college fees, books and supplies, and transportation and personal expenses. These awards will be targeted to students who – like Carey – achieved academic excellence despite an economically disadvantaged background. For more information visit suny.edu.

CCC Alumni Association Scholarship offered by Cayuga Community College is available to a senior who is the child or grandchild of a graduate of Cayuga Community College. To be eligible a student must have an academic average of 80 or better, give evidence of participation in extracurricular or community service activities, and accepted and enrolled at CCC. An essay of at least 500 words detailing reasons for applying for this scholarship is required.

Coca-Cola Scholarship Based on community service, academics, and SAT/ACT scores. Students with a 3.0 GPA and are planning to attend two and/or four years schools are encouraged to apply. Each year 150 students are chosen to receive a \$20,000 scholarship towards furthering their education. CSEA College Scholarship (Three \$1,000 scholarships in each of CSEA's six Regions); Jardine Award in Memory of Charles Foster (One \$2,500) award to a high school student entering a SUNY School); Met Life Award in Memory of Joseph D. senior and must submit a written essay as to "what being a union member has meant to his/her family". There will be (4) \$300 scholarships awarded.

Delta Kappa Gamma Society An award of \$350 will be awarded to one outstanding female in each school in Oswego County through an application process. Applications will be in the counseling office when they become available.

Dennis James Malone Scholarship Dennis James Malone was a 2004 graduate of Hannibal High School and a lifelong member of the Hannibal community. This scholarship is awarded to a Hannibal Senior who demonstrates an active role during his or her high school years in sports, extra-curricular activities, and had a knack at being an all-around good friend and classmate. This is a one-time check in the amount of \$1,000. Scholarships are available in the spring.

Dollars for Scholars will award several scholarships to graduating seniors. The awards are usually \$250-\$500 each and many colleges will double these awards. Counselors will explain the application process when these scholarships become available.

Dorothea Deitz Memorial Scholarship This scholarship is for women entering the field of physical education. This scholarship will be based on character, physical education competence, leadership and financial need. Applicants must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA. A minimum of \$1,000 will be awarded to 2 – 10 scholars. The application is open in the spring. Hannibal Free Library This scholarship is awarded to one deserving senior who plays an active role in the community, with attention paid to the library or working with literature and overall good grades. This scholarship is chosen by the Hannibal Free Library. No application is necessary.

Hannibal Home and School Scholarship This organization will award scholarships to graduating seniors at Hannibal High School. The primary criteria for these awards will be service to school and/or community. Applications available in May.

Hannibal Senior Student Council Scholarship will award a \$250 scholarship to a graduating senior based on an application, academic achievement, and an essay. Applications available in May.

Kiwanis – New York State District Kiwanis Foundation All students nominated will be evaluated based on scholastic achievement, merit, need and career goals. There will be (4) \$1,000 awards. Announcements will be made when scholarship becomes available.

National Peace Essay Contest is for students in grades 9 – 12. Students will be judged based on a 1,500 word essay. New York Schools Insurance Reciprocal (NYSIR) will offer two separate memorial scholarships ranging from \$3,000 - \$5,000. The first scholarship is available to reward a special education student who has worked through his/her special challenges to complete high school and gain acceptance into a college or university. This scholarship is in memory of Cristin Ann Bambino. The second scholarship will be awarded to a student who has excelled in design in his or her high school career. Oswego Players Scholarship is an award given to a high school senior living in Oswego County and planning to study in the field of Performing Arts at a two or four year institution.

Oswego Players Theater Group Marion Green Scholarship will give an award to a graduating senior residing in Oswego County. The student must be college bound and plan to study in the field of Fine Arts or English Writing Arts at a two or four year institution.

Oswego Teachers' Employees Federal Credit Union will award (1) \$500 and fourteen (14) \$250 scholarships to eligible seniors. Outstanding Students of America Competition is open to any senior with a GPA of 3.0 or higher and active in community service and school activities. The scholarship is payable to the college of student's choice. Over the last few years they have awarded over \$55,000 in \$1,000 awards to each student selected. Philanthropic Educational Organization (PEO) offers scholarships to high school senior girls for undergraduate study at a college of the recipient's choice. Applicants must be in the upper half of their high school class. Selections are based on the applicants' academic records and financial need. Deadline is first week of November. Applications will be available in the counseling office.

Polish Scholarship Fund Inc. will award ten (10), one-year scholarships, each valued at \$1,000. The scholarship can be used at any accredited college, university or trade school. Students are eligible who are of Polish descent, have resided in the following counties: Cayuga, Cortland, Madison, Oneida, Onondaga and Oswego for a minimum of two years and who have been accepted to any accredited post-graduate program. Preference will be given to a student who plans to become an educator.

Sally Whittle Memorial Scholarship is sponsored by the Syracuse Sounds of Music Association to honor Sally Whittle. This scholarship is to be awarded annually to a senior music student in good academic standing and planning to pursue a career as a performing musician. The scholarship will be \$1,000.

Scout of the Year The Veterans of Foreign Wars of the US awards three individuals who are: Eagle Scouts, Girl Scout Gold Award recipients, Venture Summit Award recipients and/or Sea Scout Quartermasters who have risen above their peers in exemplifying the qualities of that rank. Awards range from \$1,000 to \$5,000.

Section III Scholarship The purpose of the Section III Scholarship is to provide financial assistance toward higher education while fostering and recognizing the character development opportunities and life lessons that are engrained in Interscholastic Athletics. Students must have earned at least one varsity letter in two different sports. Applications are available in early spring.

Senior Airman Dennis Malone Dennis Malone was a 2004 graduate of Hannibal High School and a lifelong member of the Hannibal community. This scholarship is awarded to a Hannibal Senior who plans to join any branch of the military after graduation. This is a one-time check in the amount of \$1,000. It will be mailed to the winner upon notification to the family that basic training/boot camp has been completed. Applications available in spring.

Shirley Cianfarano This scholarship is in memory of Shirley Cianfarano, a graduate of Hannibal High School, a school district employee, and a lifelong member of the Hannibal community. This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a Hannibal Senior based on their dedication to the community, citizenship, strength of character, academic excellence, workmanship, commitment, leadership, and school spirit. This scholarship will be awarded in the second semester of college.

SRC Science Technology Engineering and Math (STEM) Scholarships are open to high school seniors who have a GPA of 3.0 or higher, plan to major in the STEM field and are Central New York residents.
