

When and where is the budget vote?

The annual School District Board of Education Election and Budget Vote will take place from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. on Tuesday, May 18, 2021, at Hannibal High School. Please park in the district office parking lot and follow the signage on the entry door for voting location.

How do I vote?

Votes may be cast either in-person on May 18 or via an absentee ballot. It is advised that voters request an absentee ballot (if not voting in-person) no later than May 10. To ensure timely delivery and receipt, please mail your completed absentee ballot to the district clerk by May 13, or hand-deliver it to the district clerk by 9 p.m. May 18.
