2018-2019 Academic Intervention Services

At the June 2017 meeting, the Board of Regents voted to amend the Commissioner's Regulations § 100.2 regarding the methodology by which school districts identify students to receive Academic Intervention Services (AIS). The amended procedure is still in effect.

In a memo dated September 11, 2018 it states, "For the 2018-19 school year, districts shall continue to identify students to receive AIS in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics based on Grades 3-8 scores through a two-step process. First, all students performing below the median scale score between a Level 2/partially proficient and a Level 3/proficient on a Grade 3-8 ELA or Mathematics state assessment shall be considered for AIS. Second, upon identification of a student for consideration for AIS, districts shall then use a district-developed procedure that considers multiple-measures of student performance for determining which students shall receive AIS. The district-developed procedure must be applied uniformly at each grade level."

The Hannibal Central School District's procedure for determining eligibility is as follows:

- All students who fall at or below the median scale score identified above on a state assessment will be considered potentially eligible.
- The historical performance of students, including results on AIMSWeb Plus reading and math benchmarking assessments, previous 3-8 state assessment, report card grades, and teacher recommendations will be reviewed in making final determinations in identifying a student for AIS.
